Dr. Alexandra Levine will be the Keynote Speaker for the CARES Annual Meeting



Dr. Alexandra Levine graduated from the USC/Keck School of Medicine. She did her internship and residency in Internal Medicine and fellowship in Hematology at LAC+USC Medical Center. She spent over 45 years as a physician in leadership positions, as Chief of Hematology at USC, as the Medical Director of USC/Norris Cancer Hospital for its first 20 years, and for the last 10 years, as Chief Medical Officer at City of Hope. Along the way, she was asked by President Clinton to serve on his Presidential Advisory Council on HIV/AIDS where she was chosen Chair of the Research Committee. She did extensive research in both HIV/AIDS, and in the field of cancers of the blood system, publishing over 350 articles in the peer reviewed literature. She speaks nationally and internationally on topics as diverse as the immunotherapy of cancer, and the

importance of emotional caring as part of any therapeutic regimen. CARES is very honored to welcome Dr. Levine back to

LAC+USC and to the podium.

In Memoriam: Thomas Van Cleave Berne, M.D.

Dr. Thomas Berne dedicated his life to surgery: teaching, patient care, and research. A graduate of USC Medical School in 1960, he completed his surgical residency at the now LAC+USC Medical Center. After serving as a Fellow in renal transplantation at Guys Hospital in London, he established a renal transplant program and performed the first kidney transplant operation at LAC+USC, and was also instrumental in establishing the Level 1 Trauma Center here at the Medical Center. Through his mentorship, he has inspired doctors now working throughout the world.

Happily married to his wife Cynthia for 60 years, they Dr. Berne, I have this vision met in high school and he proposed on the bank of the Seine in Paris. Tom (W6TAG), a ham radio operator from his teens, combined this passion with his concern for public health and safety to coordinate disaster preparedness activities in Silver Lake and Royal Oaks. An expert on "Historic General Hospital," Dr. Berne toured memorable areas of the building with Huell Howser of KCET.
